12:00 AM is called midnight.

Thu. is an abbreviation for Thursday.

There are 12 months in a year.

Saturday and Sunday are also called the weekend.

There are 365 days in a common year.

Sun. is an abbreviation for Sunday.

January is the first month of the year.

One hour equals 60 minutes

Tue. is an abbreviation for Tuesday.

12:00 PM is called noon.

August is after July but before September.

There are 52 weeks in a year.

Wed. is an abbreviation for Wednesday.

December is the last month of the year.

There are 60 seconds in one minute.

March is the third month of the year.

Fri. is an abbreviation for Friday.

The 4 seasons are Summer, Fall, Winter, and Spring.

There are 366 days in a Leap Year which usually occurs every 4 years.

April, June, September, and November have 30 days.

October is the tenth month of the year.

24 hours equals one day.

Mon. is an abbreviation for Monday.

January, March, May, July, August, October, and December have 31 days.

February has 28 days in a common year and 29 days in a leap year.
